WHY YOU NEED SCHOOL

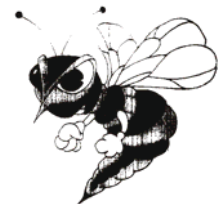
Graduating from high school will determine how well you live for the next 50 years of your life.

California Strawberry Scholarships are available for full-time enrollment at a college, university, community college, or accredited trade school.** Scholarship awards start at \$400 and can be renewed annually. The scholarship amount is based on merit.
