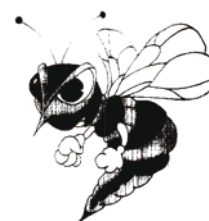

Seniors**Scholarships**

1. **Collegeisnext.com** is a local website for scholarship links and lots of college info.
2. **Best Buy Scholarship Program:** apply online at www.bestbuy-communityrelations.com or www.at15.com dead line is Feb. 15, 2012.
3. **California Strawberry Scholarships are available for full-time enrollment at a college, university, community college, or accredited trade school.** Scholarship awards start at \$400 and can be renewed annually. The scholarship amount is based on merit. Funding is available for graduating high school seniors and students already attending college, including advanced degrees (master's or doctorate degrees), or professional certification (teaching credential, technical programs, etc.). **Applicants submit online applications at www.californiastrawberries.com/scholarships. The application deadline is Tuesday, March 1, 2012.**
4. **Juniors & Seniors: SCAG Scholarship**—must have a 3.0 GPA and be eligible to work in the US, must be planning to attend college or university. Student must complete an application form and essay, provide 2 letters of recommendation, and a current transcript. Applications are available at www.scaq.ca.gov/scholarship all materials should be submitted by March 9, 2012.
5. **Italian Catholic Federation:** Graduating Seniors of Italian descent who have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.2, must be Roma Catholic but not be of Italian descent to qualify. See Mrs. Peralta for an application or visit their web site at WWW.ICF.ORG application deadline: March 15, 2012.
6.
