The District serves the communities of Calipatria, Niland and the Bombay Beach/Hot Mineral Spas communities along the southeastern edge of the Salton Sea. This district enrolls approximately 1200 students in grades K-12. There are 4 school sites located within the district. The Grace Smith Elementary School (K-5), located in Niland, serves approximately 130 students.
